

Parks Board Resolution 2025-07
A Resolution of the Logansport
Parks and Recreation Board
Amending the Prohibition of the Use of Alcoholic Beverages in City Parks
Excepting Certain Circumstances
Granted by the Logansport Parks Board
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WHEREAS, The Logansport Parks & Recreation Board governs the facilities within the Logansport Parks Department as provided by the Logansport City Council Ordinance 97-42;

WHEREAS, in general, the ongoing prohibition for the use of alcoholic beverages in the parks of the City of Logansport has proven to be beneficial during the normal use of our community parks.

WHEREAS, The Logansport Parks Board does now see cause to make an exception to the general prohibition of alcohol use for special community events in the specific parks of Fairview Park, Heritage Park, Huston Park, Little Turtle Waterway Plaza &/or lawn, the Penman Building, Riverside Park, and Spencer Park,

WHEREAS, The Logansport Parks Board does now see that the sale of liquor, beer and wine at the Dykeman Park Municipal Golf Course would financially benefit the operations of the course as well as making Dykeman more competitive with other golf courses.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City of Logansport Parks & Recreation Board that:

SECTION 1: Ordinances 76-1, 83-33, 08-23, 21-26 and shall be repealed in their entirety.

SECTION 2: Under the regulations of the Indiana Alcoholic Beverage Laws and Rules stated in Title 7.1 of the Indiana Code, the Logansport Parks & Recreation Board shall be granted authority to sell liquor, beer and wine at the Dykeman Park Municipal Golf Course utilizing procedures established by the Logansport Parks & Recreation Board. See attached Standard Operating Procedures for the Sale/Use of Liquor, Beer & Wine.

SECTION 3: The Logansport Parks & Recreation Board shall have the authority to grant exceptions to Section 4 below under the following circumstances:

- a) A community event which shall be located at Fairview Park, Heritage Park, Huston Park, Little Turtle Waterway Plaza &/or lawn, the Penman Building, Riverside Park, and Spencer Park, and is sponsored by a community organization.
- b) Evidence is provided by the community organization thirty days in advance that:
 - o A temporary liquor / beer / wine permit has been received;
 - o The City of Logansport has been provided with the following:
 - A Certificate of Insurance naming the City of Logansport as additional insured. Additional insured coverage shall apply as primary insurance and shall not be less than the following minimum insurance limits:
 - Comprehensive General Liability
 - o Bodily Injury - \$1,000,000 per occurrence
 - o Property Damage - \$1,000,000 per occurrence
 - o or Combined / Single Limit - \$1,000,000 per occurrence
 - o Aggregate Limits – Policy \$1,000,000

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Such insurance shall cover liability arising from premises operations, independent contractors, products-completed operations, personal and advertising injury, and liability assumed under an insured contract.

- Liquor Liability is required as follows: \$1,000,000 per occurrence, \$1,000,000 per aggregate.
 - The minimum limits of coverage required by this subcontract may be satisfied by a combination of primary and excess umbrella insurance policies.
 - All such policies of insurance shall contain a provision that the same shall not be canceled nor the coverage modified nor the limits changed without first giving thirty (30) days written notice thereof to the City of Logansport.
 - City of Logansport, IN shall be named as additional insured on such required policies.
- A licensed alcoholic beverage caterer has been employed to serve alcoholic beverages;
- A minimum of 2 off-duty policemen have been privately employed to contain and monitor the consumption of alcohol within a defined perimeter;
- Food is being served in association with the event.
- c) A statement of agreement is signed by the community organization that all alcohol being consumed by their guests has originated from their licensed caterer; and that a Certificate of Insurance showing coverage for Liquor Liability naming the City of Logansport has been provided.
- d) The community organization has paid the appropriate deposits and rental fees.

SECTION 4: Except for circumstances as stated above in Sections 2 & 3, it shall continue to be unlawful for any person to possess, carry, transport, drink, use or consume, sell or offer for sale, trade, barter, give away or exchange any malt, vinous, or spirituous alcoholic beverage or liquor in, upon, or within the confines of any park which are now owned or will be owned, operated, or maintained by the City of Logansport, Indiana and are managed now and in the future by the Logansport Parks Board. This includes the picnic pavilions at Dykeman Park.

SECTION 5: Except for circumstances as stated above in Sections 2 & 3, anyone who violates Section 4 shall upon conviction, be fined in any sum not to exceed One Thousand (\$1,000) Dollars. Fines are payable to the City of Logansport in the Clerk-Treasurer's Office and will be deposited into the General Fund. Fines are assessed as follows: 1st offense: \$250; 2nd offense: \$500; 3rd offense: \$1000; 4th offense: Expulsion from the parks permanently.


SECTION 6: Any provision in previous Parks Board resolutions that is inconsistent with any provision in this resolution is hereby repealed.

SECTION 7: That this resolution shall be in full force and effect after its passage by the Logansport Parks & Recreation Board and passage by the Logansport Common Council.


