CALL TO ORDER

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Approval of the minutes from the June 30, 2026, meeting.

TRANSFER TO THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION

The Commission for Higher Education (CHE) requests a transfer of \$7,500,000 from the Career Coaching Grant Fund (12388) to Department of Education's (DOE) Career Advising Grant Fund (12387). Pursuant to Indiana Code 20-19-12, the Department of Education (DOE) is responsible for administering the program. The Career Coaching Grant was established for the purpose of providing grants to eligible entities to develop or implement comprehensive career navigation and coaching systems. DOE will work with career coaches, schools, and other eligible entities to ensure that funds are distributed appropriately to career coaching services who have work experience outside of teaching.

TRANSFER TO THE COMMISSION FOR HIGHER EDUCATION

The Department of Education (DOE) requests to transfer of \$1,220,000 from the Tuition Support Fund (14930) to Commission for Higher Education's (CHE) Mitch Daniels Early Graduation Scholarship Fund (48692). Pursuant to Indiana Code 21-12-10-2, CHE is to administer the program. These dollars represent one-time scholarships for students who graduate at least one year early from a publicly supported Indiana high school. To claim this scholarship, students must enroll at an eligible Indiana institution no later than the fall semester in the academic year immediately following the year they graduate high school.

TRANSFER TO THE CRIMINAL JUSTICE INSTITUTE

The Governor's Office requests a transfer of \$5,000,000 from the Substance Abuse Preventive Treatment Enforcement Fund (57876) to the Indiana Criminal Justice Institute's (ICJI) Substance Abuse Preventive, Treatment, and Enforcement Fund (57871). Pursuant to an MOU between the agencies, CJI will utilize these funds to coordinate the state's efforts on substance abuse prevention, treatment, and enforcement, providing planning, and collaboration across state agencies and the local level.

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TRANSFER TO THE MOTOR VEHICLE HIGHWAY ACCOUNT

At the request of the Governor, the State Budget Agency requests a transfer of \$78,602,772.02 from the State Highway Fund (30519) to the Motor Vehicle Highway Account (30112). This amount represents the gasoline use tax revenue (\$14,019,451.60) and the gasoline excise tax revenue (\$64,583,320.42) that would have been collected during the period from April 8, 2026, through May 31, 2026, and transferred to the Motor Vehicle Highway Account, had the gasoline use tax and gasoline excise tax not been suspended.

TRANSFER TO THE HIGHWAY, ROAD, AND STREET FUND

At the request of the Governor, the State Budget Agency requests a transfer of \$21,527,773.47 from the State Highway Fund (30519) to the Highway, Road, and Street Fund (50530). This amount represents the gasoline excise tax revenue that would have been collected during the period from May 6, 2026, through May 31, 2026, and transferred to the Highway, Road, and Street Fund, had the gasoline excise tax not been suspended.

TRANSFER TO THE LOCAL ROAD AND BRIDGE MATCHING FUND

At the request of the Governor, the State Budget Agency requests a transfer of \$21,029,177.40 from the State Highway Fund (30519) to the Local Road and Bridge Matching Fund (44228). This amount represents the gasoline use tax revenue that would have been collected during the period from April 8, 2026, through May 31, 2026, and transferred to the Local Road and Bridge Matching Fund, had the gasoline use tax not been suspended.
