

**ORDINANCE NO. 2025-02**

**AN ORDINANCE  
OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF CARROLL COUNTY, INDIANA  
AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF CARROLL COUNTY, INDIANA  
REVISING, AMENDING, RESTATING, CODIFYING AND COMPILING CERTAIN EXISTING  
GENERAL ORDINANCES OF CARROLL COUNTY, INDIANA IN SUCH CODE OF  
ORDINANCES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the Acts of the Legislature of the State of Indiana empower and authorize Carroll County, Indiana to revise, amend, restate, codify, and compile any existing ordinances and all new ordinances not heretofore adopted or published and to incorporate such ordinances into one ordinance in book form; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Carroll County, Indiana has authorized a revision of the Code of Ordinances of Carroll County, Indiana, including the codification of the general ordinances of Carroll County enacted since the first codification in 2010; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to provide for the usual daily operation of the municipality and for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and general welfare of the municipality that this ordinance take effect at an early date.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF CARROLL COUNTY, INDIANA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The general ordinances of Carroll County, Indiana as revised, amended, restated, codified, and compiled in book form are hereby adopted as and shall constitute the "Code of Ordinances of Carroll County, Indiana."

Section 2. Such Code of Ordinances as adopted in Section 1 shall consist of the following Titles:

Section 3. All prior ordinances pertaining to the subjects treated in such Code of Ordinances shall be deemed repealed from and after the effective date of this ordinance except as they are included and readopted in whole or in part in such Code; provided, such repeal shall not affect any offense committed or penalty incurred or any right established prior to the effective date of this ordinance, nor shall such repeal affect the provisions of ordinances levying taxes, appropriating money, annexing or detaching territory, establishing franchises, or granting special rights to certain persons, authorizing public improvements, authorizing the issuance of bonds or borrowing of money, authorizing the purchase or sale of real or personal property, granting or accepting easements, plat or dedication of land to public use, vacating or setting the boundaries of streets or other public places; nor shall such repeal affect any other ordinance of a temporary or special nature or pertaining to subjects not contained in or covered by the Code.

Section 4. Such Code shall be deemed published as of the day of its adoption and approval by the Board of Commissioners of Carroll County, Indiana, and the Auditor is hereby authorized and ordered to file a copy of such Code of Ordinances in the Office of the Auditor.

Section 5. Such Code shall be in full force and effect as provided in Section 6, and such Code shall be presumptive evidence in all courts and agencies, and all provisions, sections, penalties and regulations therein contained and of the date of passage, and that the same is properly signed, attested, recorded, and approved and that any public hearings and notices thereof as required by law have been given.

Section 6. This ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health, safety, and general welfare of the citizens of Carroll County, Indiana, and shall take effect at the earliest date provided by law.
