

**AN ORDINANCE
OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF CARROLL
AMENDING AND RESTATING ORDINANCE NO. 2017-07
CONCERNING DRAINAGE FEES NONREVERTING FUND**

Findings

The Board of Commissioners of the County of Carroll, of the State of Indiana (hereinafter referred to as "the Board") heretofore adopted Ordinance No. 2017-07 creating a non-reverting fund to accumulate fees collected by the office of the surveyor for plan reviews, permit inspections, alcoholic beverage permit location verifications, and inspections related to violations of the drainage code and drain obstructions. All of these necessitate the use of a vehicle, which can and should be subsidized with such fees.

The auditor has requested that the fund be restructured as a single fund, with no sub-accounts, to conform the fund to state budget policies, and the surveyor has requested changes to correctly identify the fees to be credited to the fund.

This ordinance amends and restates ordinance 2017-07 and authorizes all applicable fees collected by the office of the surveyor on or after August 21, 2017, to be transferred or appropriated to the combined non-reverting fund.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF
THE COUNTY OF CARROLL, OF THE STATE OF INDIANA, AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. The Carroll County Code is hereby amended by the addition of a new section, §31.09, entitled "Drainage Fees Nonreverting Fund", codifying the provisions of this ordinance, and hereby restating Ordinance No. 2017-07.

Section 2. There is hereby established a nonreverting fund in the accounts of Carroll County entitled "Drainage Fees Nonreverting Fund" (hereinafter referred to as the "Fund"). The Fund shall be maintained separate and apart from all other funds of Carroll County.

Section 3. All fees collected by the office of the surveyor of Carroll County on or after August 21, 2017, for plan reviews, permit inspections, alcoholic beverage permit location verifications, and inspections related to violations of the drainage code and drain obstructions shall be credited, transferred and/or appropriated to the Drainage Fees Nonreverting Fund.

Section 4. Expenditures from the Fund shall require appropriation and are subject to audit by order of the Board of Commissioners and by the State Board of Accounts. Warrants shall not be drawn against the Fund except to the extent that the same do not exceed the unencumbered balance of a proper appropriation of the Fund.

Section 5. Subject to the prior approval of the Drainage Board, the purposes for which the Drainage Fees Nonreverting Fund may be expended shall include the following:

- (a) Purchase or lease of vehicles for the exclusive use of the surveyor for official purposes;
- (b) Purchases of equipment for the exclusive use of the surveyor for official purposes; and
- (c) Purchases of engineering and consulting services.

ADOPTED this 18th day May 2026, after unanimous consent to its consideration on the date of its introduction.
