

CASS COUNTY ORDINANCE 2012-02
AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A NON-REVERTING FUND FOR THE CASS COUNTY PLANNING
DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, the Cass County Commissioners passed a Fee Schedule Ordinance, Ordinance 2011-15 on the 19 day of December, 2011; and

WHEREAS, said Ordinance provided for these fees to defray reasonable administrative cost for the Cass County Planning Department; and

WHEREAS, it would be in the best interest of the citizens of Cass County, Indiana, if said monies be deposited into a non-reverting operating fund hereby established as a line item under the Cass County Planning Department for enforcement and administration of the Zoning and Subdivision Ordinances.

NOW, BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED AND RESOLVED BY THE CASS COUNTY COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:

1. That any fee received by the Cass County Planning Department as a result of the review and inspections of new development within the unincorporated areas of Cass County to insure the health, safety, comfort, convenience, and general welfare of Cass County residents, shall be deposited into a non-reverting operating fund, which is now created.
2. That the monies in said fund shall not revert to the Cass County General Fund at the end of each fiscal year.
3. That the monies in said fund shall be used by Cass County Plan Commission for expenses related to the operation of the Planning Office.
