

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CASS COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
AMENDING TITLE VII, CHAPTER 71, SCHEDULE IV, SECTION(S) 7
OF THE CASS COUNTY CODE**

WHEREAS, the Oak Ridge Landfill is changing its traffic flow to utilize PR 300S as an exit point. A hill to the south of the intersection of CR 150E and CR/PR 300S presents a visibility concern for northbound traffic on CR 150E. Cass County Commissioners feel a necessity to place additional traffic control devices at the intersection of **CR 150E** and **CR 300S/Private Road 300S** in order to protect the general traveling public from the increased truck traffic entering the roadway at this intersection.

WHEREAS, pursuant to further continuing investigation, the Cass County Commissioners have decided that such traffic control devices need to be placed in and about such intersection;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:

Section I. Title VII, Chapter 71, Schedule IV, Section 7 of the Cass County Code is hereby amended to add the additional stop signs, creating a 4-way stop at the respectively designated intersection:


A. Stop Signs at these intersections


Northbound **CR 150 E** stops for **CR 300 S**;
Southbound **CR 150 E** stops for **CR 300 S**;
Eastbound **CR 300S** stops for **CR 150 E**;
Westbound **PR 300S** stops for **CR 150 E**;

Section II. All prior ordinances or parts hereof inconsistent with any provision of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section III. This Ordinance hereby passed and adopted at a regular meeting of the Cass County Commissioners of Cass County, Indiana, the 15 day of April, 2013.


