

ORDINANCE 2013- 03

**AN ORDINANCE GOVERNING THE USE & ENJOYMENT
OF THE PANHANDLE PATHWAY TRAIL**

WHEREAS, The Cass County Commissioners are empowered to regulate and control the traffic and use of Cass County highways and properties that are dedicated to the public use and benefit; and

WHEREAS, the Friends of the Panhandle Pathway, Inc., are the owners of a certain walking and biking trail from the Cass County/Pulaski County boundary line south to Kenneth Indiana, to which they dedicated to the public; and


WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the citizens of Cass County and the general public to establish restrictions and control for the use and benefit and enjoyment of said Trail;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDAINED BY THE
CASS COUNTY COMMISSIONERS AS FOLLOWS:**


1. The Friends of the Panhandle Pathway, Inc., dedicated a certain walking and biking trail to the public, as evidenced by the dedication recorded on March 1st, 2013, as Instrument #201300000925 in the Recorder's Office, Cass County, IN and it is that walking and biking trail that is to be governed by this Ordinance.
2. Only non-motorized recreational vehicles are permitted. No motorized vehicles of any type or nature are permitted on said trail, except for vehicles engaged in law enforcement, emergency response or trail maintenance and/or repair.
3. No horse traffic is allowed on said trail right-of-way.
4. All pets or animals controlled by any individual using the trail shall be leashed and that said leash shall not be extended longer than six feet.
5. Hunting and possession of firearms is prohibited on said Trail.
6. Any violation of these restrictions shall result in a fine of up to \$500.00 per occurrence.
7. This Ordinance shall be affective upon its passage and published notice.
