

**CASS COUNTY COUNCIL
NOVEMBER 21, 2014**

The Cass County Council met at 9:00 a.m. in the Commissioner Hearing Room. Present were George Stebbins, Jim David, Jeff LeDonne, Phil Rains, Brian Reed, Attorney John Hillis and Auditor Vaneen Ide. Absent were Stacey Donato and Grover Bishop.

MINUTES

Brian Reed made a motion to approve the minutes as presented, Jeff LeDonne seconded. The motion carried unanimously.

ADDITIONALS

The Public Defender Board requested an additional appropriation in the amount of \$26,750.00. Jeff LeDonne made a motion to approve the additional request of \$26,750.00, Phil Rains seconded. The motion carried with 4 yea votes and one nay vote from Brian Reed.

Kathy Adair, Treasurer appeared before the Council with a request for an additional appropriation in the amount of \$3,125.00 for the purchase of a Toshiba Currency Sorter. Brian Reed made a motion to approve the request for the additional in the amount of \$3,125.00. Phil Rains seconded. The motion carried with 4 yea votes and one nay from Jim David.

TRANSFERS

Kathy Adair, Treasurer requested that \$67.63 be transferred out of series. Brian Reed made a motion to approve the request to transfer \$67.63 out of series, Jeff LeDonne seconded. The motion carried unanimously.

Security made a request to have \$1464.38 transferred out of series. Brian Reed made motion to approve the request to transfer \$1464.38 out of series, Phil Rains seconded. The motion carried unanimously.

CRP MONIES

The Auditor's office received a check in the amount of \$4,785.00 from the USDA for CRP at the Park. The Auditor requested the Council decide what fund the money should be placed. Phil Rains made a motion to place it into County General, Jeff LeDonne seconded. The motion carried unanimously.

RADIOS

Cass County Sheriff Randy Pryor appeared before the Council and informed the Council, that new radios will need to be purchased. The ones currently being used are now obsolete and parts are no longer available. Sheriff Pryor is requesting funds to purchase new radios before the end of the year.


The Council requested the Auditor advertise for an additional out of Public Safety for the purchase of new radios.

PUBLIC COMMENTS


There were no public comments. Brian Reed made a motion to adjourn, Phil Rains seconded. The motion carried unanimously.






