ORDINANCE CREATING FUND NO 4810 CASS COUNTY EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY NON-REVERTING FUND FOR DONATIONS USED FOR FIRE TRAINING SERVICES

Whereas, THE Cass County Emergency Management Agency has received a community foundation Grant of \$30,000.00 for a Fire Training Center;

WHEREAS, the Cass County Emergency Management Agency's purpose for creating a non-reverting fund is for future donations from community partners, future grants, donations or contributions from government agencies; and

WHEREAS, the express intent of any future grants and/or donations is that it be dedicated for facility maintenance, improvement and support of the training programs to be held at the training facility.

WHEREAS, the Cass County Council desires that any grants and/or donations be deposited into a non-reverting fund (EMA Fire Training Non-Rev Fund #4810) which, in addition to any other money provided by the County Council, will be utilized to pay for fire training services/education, equipment and equipment maintenance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CASS COUNTY COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. This Ordinance creates a non-reverting fund (EMA Fire Training Non-Rev Fund # 4810) for revenue and donations received for services provided by the Cass County Emergency Management Agency for Fire Training Services.
- 2. The money in this non-reverting fund (EMA Fire Training Non-Rev Fund # 4810) shall remain in said fund (EMA Fire Training Non-Rev Fund # 4810) until expended and shall not revert to the general fund at the end of the county's fiscal year.
- 3. The monies in said fund (EMA Fire Training Non-Rev Fund # 4810) shall be utilized to pay all expenses incurred by Cass County Emergency Management Agency facility maintenance, improvement and support of the training programs to be held at the training facility.
