

RESOLUTION 2026-05

**A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF CASS COUNTY, INDIANA AUTHORIZING
INFRASTRUCTURE FUNDS FOR THE INSTALLATION OF A HANDICAP
ACCESSIBLE SIDEWALK FROM THE INDIANA HEALTH CLINIC (IHC) TO THE
CASS COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT**

WHEREAS, the Executive Director of Area 5 Agency on Aging and Community Services recently brought to the attention of the Logansport Common Council a need for a handicap accessible sidewalk between Indiana Health Clinic (IHC) and the Cass County Health Department; and

WHEREAS, the Executive Director provided a proposed sidewalk connection between the IHC and the Cass County Health Department as well as an estimate from Shepler Construction to complete an ADA approved sidewalk in the amount of \$12,670.00 with a request that the city and county split the cost of construction; and

WHEREAS, there is presently no sidewalk which connects the properties, which at times share clients who are in need of medical assistance; and

WHEREAS, The Council for the City of Logansport has already approved \$6,380 to contribute to half of the cost of the project, and the Cass County Commissioners have approved the construction project on the County Health Department Property.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of Cass County, Indiana as follows:

Section 1: The funding for the sidewalk project with Shepler Construction connecting the Indiana Health Clinic (IHC) and the Cass County Health Department is approved.

Section 2: The County shall also contribute \$6,380 to the project, to be paid out of fund # 2502.


