August 21, 2020

The Cass County Council met at 9:00 a.m. in the Commissioner Hearing Room. Present were Bruce Ide, Grover Bishop, Mike Stajduhar, Dave Redweik, Tracy Williamson, Brian Reed, George Stebbins, Auditor Cheryl Alcorn, and Attorney Jeff Stanton.

Mike Stajduhar opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance and a moment of silence following.

Dave Redweik made a motion to table Ordinance 20-05 and Ordinance 20-06, Mike Stajduhar seconded.


After discussion Redweik withdrew the motion.


