

RESOLUTION 2012 - 02
A CASS COUNTY COMMISSIONERS AMENDMENT TO
THE CASS COUNTY COMPREHENSIVE PLAN FOR
FUTURE LAND USE MAP AREA SOUTH OF 8086 W. 900 S

WHEREAS, The General Assembly of the State of Indiana granted powers to the cities and towns to adopt and amend a comprehensive plan in accordance with IC 36-7-4-500 series; and

WHEREAS, The Cass County Commissioners have adopted the Cass County Comprehensive Plan effective July 20, 2009; and

WHEREAS, IC 36-7-4-503 allows plans of this nature to include maps of current and future land use as a part of the comprehensive plan; and

WHEREAS, The Cass County Plan Commission held a public hearing on Monday, June 11, 2012 and voted to certify with a favorable recommendation to the Cass County Commissioners as specified in the attached amendments to the Cass County Comprehensive Plan Future Land Use Map; and

WHEREAS, The Cass County Commissions believe there is merit in amending the Cass County Comprehensive Plan Future Land Use Map with the attached amendment, in order to promote the public health, safety, comfort, morals, convenience and general welfare of the community; now, therefore be it


RESOLVED by the Commissioners of Cass County, Indiana as follows:

SECTION 1: That the Cass County Comprehensive Plan (Ordinance 2009-03) is amended to re-classify the Future Land Use Map designation of Agricultural to Industrial for the following area:
Properties directly south of 8086 W. 900 S., Cass County, Indiana.
Legal description as follows: A Fractional part of the west half (1/2) of section eight (8), Township twenty-five (25) north, range three (3) east, Jackson Township, Cass County, Indiana

SECTION 2: That this amendment shall be in full force and effect upon its passage by the Commissioner of Cass County, Indiana.

DULY PASSED AND RESOLVED this 2 day of July 2012, by the Commissioners of Cass County, Indiana by a vote of 3 in favor and 0 opposed.


