

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CASS COUNTY COMMISSIONERS  
AMENDING TITLE VII, CHAPTER 71, SCHEDULE IV, SECTION(S) 7  
OF THE CASS COUNTY CODE**

**WHEREAS**, the Cass County Commissioners feel a necessity to change the traffic control device at the intersection of **CR 1250S** and **CR 1000E** in order to protect the general traveling public using public road intersections.

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to further continuing investigation, the Cass County Commissioners have decided that such traffic control devices need to be placed in and about such intersection;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section I.** Title VII, Chapter 71, Schedule IV, Section 2 of the Cass County Code is hereby amended to change the yield sign to a stop sign at the respectively designated intersection:


A. Eastbound **CR 1250S** stops for **CR 1000E**

**Section II.** All prior ordinances or parts hereof inconsistent with any provision of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

**Section III.** This Ordinance hereby passed and adopted at a regular meeting of the Cass County Commissioners of Cass County, Indiana, the 3 day of September, 2013.
