

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CASS COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
AMENDING TITLE VII, CHAPTER 71, SCHEDULE IV, SECTION(S) 5
OF THE CASS COUNTY CODE**

WHEREAS, the Cass County Commissioners feel a necessity to place additional traffic control devices at the intersection of **Stoney Pike** and **Stoney Pike connector** in order to protect the general traveling public.

WHEREAS, pursuant to further continuing investigation, the Cass County Commissioners have decided that such traffic control devices need to be placed in and about such intersection;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:

Section I. Title VII, Chapter 71, Schedule IV, Section 5 of the Cass County Code is hereby amended to change a yield sign to a stop sign at the respectively designated intersection:

A. Stop Signs at these intersections


Eastbound **Stoney Pike** stops for **Stoney Pike Connector**.


Section II. All prior ordinances or parts hereof inconsistent with any provision of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section III. This Ordinance hereby passed and adopted at a regular meeting of the Cass County Commissioners of Cass County, Indiana, the 18 day of August, 2014.
