

CASS COUNTY COUNCIL ORDINANCE NO. 2026-01

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A NON-REVERTING FUND FOR REVENUE
AND REIMBURSEMENTS RECEIVED BY CASS COUNTY FOR HOUSING
INMATES

WHEREAS, Cass County, by and through its County Sherriff, operates and maintains a County Detention Center/ Jail for housing inmates charged and or convicted of crimes;

WHEREAS, since the recent expansion of the Cass County Detention Center/Jail the Cass County Sheriff has offered space, in the Detention Center/Jail, to surrounding Counties to house their inmates for an agreed upon fee;

WHEREAS, it is anticipated that the Cass County Sheriff may also, in the future, house inmates for the United States Government;

WHEREAS, the Cass County Council desires and hereby establishes this Ordinance which provides that a portion of the revenue and/or reimbursements generated from the housing of inmates for other Indiana Counties and future expected revenue and reimbursements for housing Federal (United States Government) inmates should be deposited into a Non-Reverting Fund #4050

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CASS COUNTY COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:

1. This Ordinance (2026-01) hereby creates a new non-reverting fund # 4050 the purpose of which is to deposit revenue and reimbursements received for services provided by the Cass County Sheriff's Department for the housing of inmates for other Indiana Counties and for the (United States Government) Federal Government.

2. This Ordinance (2026-01) provides that fifty percent (50%) of revenue and reimbursements received from other Indiana Counties and from the (United States) Federal Government for the housing of inmates shall be set aside and deposited into this Non-Reverting Fund # 4050. The remaining fifty percent (50%) shall continue to be deposited into the County General Fund, Fund #1000-10059.

3. The revenue and reimbursements deposited into this non-reverting fund # 4050 shall remain in said fund # 4050 until expended and shall not revert to the general fund

at the end of the county's fiscal year.


4. The monies in said fund #4050 shall be utilized for the sole purpose to offset expenses incurred by the Cass County Sheriff's Department for the Cass County Jail maintenance, upkeep, and renovations.




