A write-in vote will NOT be counted unless the vote is for a DECLARED write-in candidate. To vote for a writein candidate, you must make a voting mark on or in the square to the left of the name you have written in or your vote will not be counted.

You are not required to vote a straight party ticket.
If you do not wish to vote a straight party ticket, do not make a mark in this section, and proceed to voting the ballot by office.

To vote a straight Republican, Democratic, or Libertarian party ticket for all Republican, Democratic, or Libertarian candidates on this ballot, except for candidates described below, make a voting mark on or in the box of the corresponding party, and do not make any other marks on this ballot.

To Vote for any candidate for an At-Large Office (Township Boards and Town Councils) you must make another voting mark for each candidate you wish to vote for. Your straight party vote will not count as a vote for any candidate for that office.

If you wish to vote for a candidate seeking a nonpartisan office (School Board) you must make another voting mark on the appropriate place on this ballot.
