

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CASS COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
AMENDING TITLE 7, SCHEDULE 2, SECTION(S) A
OF THE CASS COUNTY CODE**

WHEREAS, the Cass County Commissioners feel a necessity to temporarily place a limit of thru traveling commercial truck traffic on certain county roads in Washington, Deer Creek, and Clinton Townships in order to protect the general traveling public.

WHEREAS, pursuant to further continuing investigation, the Cass County Commissioners have decided that temporary traffic control devices need to be placed on such roadways for the duration of the SR 29/329 closure in this area in calendar year 2025;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:

Section I. Title 7, Schedule 2, Section A of the Cass County Code is hereby amended to add the following temporary regulatory signage:

A. "NO COMMERCIAL TRUCKS"

All thru commercial trucks are prohibited from using the following roads:

CR 1150S from Carroll County line to 50E

CR 1050S from Carroll County line to 50E

CR 50E from 1150S to 400S

CR 200E from SR 218 to 400S

CR 400S from SR 29 to 200E

CR 50E from 350S to Logansport city limit

CR 150E from 300S to 400S

CR 350S from 50E to 150E

CR 300S from SR 29 to 150E

CR 400W from 500S to 400S

Section II. Truck Traffic is defined in Title 7, Schedule II, Section B of the Cass County Code as the following: "semitrailer"; Every vehicle with or without motive power other than a pull trailer designed for carrying persons or property and for being drawn by a motor vehicle and so constructed that some part of its weight and that of its load rests upon or is carried by another vehicle. "truck tractor"; Every motor vehicle designed and used primarily for drawing other vehicles and not so constructed as to carry a load other than a part of the weight of the vehicle and load so drawn. Furthermore, "Thru" trucks is defined as any truck not having an origin or destination on said section of roadway.

Section III. All prior ordinances or parts hereof inconsistent with any provision of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section IV. This Ordinance hereby passed and adopted at a regular meeting of the Cass County Commissioners of Cass County, Indiana, the 7 day of April, 2025.


