CASS COUNTY COUNCIL ORDINANCE 2024-22

A JOINT ORDINANCE OF THE CASS COUNTY COMMISSIONERS AND CASS COUNTY COUNCIL ESTABLISHING A CASH CHANGE FUND FOR COUNTY TREASURER

WHEREAS, the Commissioners and the Council of Cass County, Indiana recognizes that cash funds should be available to the Cass County Treasurer for the purpose of making cash change for small or emergency transactions, especially when property taxes are due, all as provided by IC 36-1-8-2; and

WHEREAS, the County Treasurer will be the custodian of such a cash change fund.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Commissioners and the Council of Cass County hereby establishes an Ordinance which provides that the Cass County Treasurer may maintain a cash change fund in the amount of five hundred dollars (\$500.00) throughout the year, except as provided below; and


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that in the month prior to the due date for real property taxes, there is a need for cash funds to make change in excess of five hundred dollars (\$500.00); and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that for four (4) weeks prior to the due date for real property tax installments, the Cass County Treasurer may maintain a cash fund in the amount of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00); and


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all replenishments to this fund will follow the procedures outline in IC 36-1-8-1 et. Seq. and the Indiana State Board of Accounts Accounting and Uniform Compliance Guidelines for Indiana Counties.






