

CASS COUNTY COUNCIL ORDINANCE NO. 2025-04

ORDINANCE APPROVING RECORDER'S REQUEST TO USE THE COUNTY
RECORDER'S RECORDS PERPETUATION FUND TO SUPPORT ALL
OPERATING EXPENSES FOR 2026

WHEREAS, I.C. § 36-2-7-10.2 permits an Indiana County Recorder to pay all or a portion of the expenses of the County Recorder's Office from the County Recorder's Records Perpetuation Fund; and

WHEREAS, the Cass County Recorder has submitted a sworn statement that the current revenue to the fund is sufficient to fulfill the statutory purpose of the fund; and

WHEREAS, the Cass County Recorder has submitted a sworn statement that the fund has a sufficient reserve consistent with the Recorder's plan to capitalize the next technology or other records management upgrade necessary to fulfill the statutory purpose of the fund and the Cass County Recorder has specifically requested that the fund be used to pay the expenses of the Cass County Recorder for the 2026 calendar year.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:

The Cass County Council now having received the Cass County Recorder's sworn statement, hereby adopts this Ordinance approving the Cass County Recorder's request to utilize the County Recorder's Records Perpetuation Fund to pay the expenses of the Cass County Recorder's Office for the 2026 calendar year.

Filed and approved on the first reading by a vote of 6 in favor and 0 opposed on the 10th day of June 2025.


