

RESOLUTION OF THE CLARK COUNTY ELECTION BOARD

WHEREAS, Indiana Code permits a county election board to authorize qualified individuals who are at least sixteen (16) years of age and less than eighteen (18) years of age to serve as precinct election officers; and

WHEREAS, the Clark County Election Board finds that allowing eligible students to serve as poll workers promotes civic engagement and assists in the administration of elections;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Clark County Election Board as follows:

1. Authorization

Individuals who are at least sixteen (16) years of age and less than eighteen (18) years of age are authorized to serve as Precinct Clerks for the May 5, 2026 Primary Election and the November 3, 2026 General Election, subject to Indiana law.


2. Eligibility

Eligible students must meet all requirements under Indiana Code and serve under the supervision of the precinct inspector.

3. Effective Date

This resolution shall take effect immediately upon approval.


