RE: Complaint/questions regarding Campaign Finance Reports

Please be advised that we are requesting the Election Board review the expenditures listed on 2023 campaign finance reports for three separate committees/PACs listed on the following pages 2, 3 and 4.

Please note that these are just a few of the questionable expenditures on these and many other campaign finance forms but were selected as initial items for the Election Board to review. There are many others.

The concern is that these forms are not audited or reviewed by anyone. While these items might be legitimate, there is no way for anyone to know since there is no oversight.

Please note that various federal relevant laws and Indiana codes are cited beginning on page 5.

Hoosiers for Jeffersonville PAC – Chuck Moore, chairperson; Angela Moore, Treasurer – replaced by Judith VanGilder on 4/13/24.

46 Arctic Springs, Jeffersonville, IN 47130

Expenditures in question:

1. The UPS Store -- \$540 paid on 4/21/23 for “post office box” (yet campaign address is 46 Arctic Springs, not a P.O box)
2. MDL Strategies – 3310-4 E. 10th Street #359, Jeffersonville, IN -- \$7,500 paid 7/31/23 for “consulting fee”. MDL Strategies was not found on the Secretary of State website and there is no street address listed, just a P.O. box.)
3. Scott McVoy - \$13,500 paid on 10/16/23 plus another \$13,500 on 10/18/23 (total of \$27,000) – 12524 Greenbriar Blvd., Sellersburg, IN – “consulting fee/fundraising”. (Mr. McVoy said this was compensation for organizing the mayor’s golf event. If so, why it wasn’t paid by the “I’m for Mike Moore” campaign)
4. Jeff Republicans PAC - \$24,500 paid on 9/7/23 plus another \$2195 paid on 11/30/23 – 3310-4 E. 10th Street #359, Jeffersonville for “contributions”.

**Jeff Republicans Political Action Committee – Ron Grooms, chairperson;
Angela Merkley, treasurer 3310-4 E. 10th St. #359, Jeffersonville, IN**

(NOTE: this PAC was organized on 9/1/23 and disbanded on January 16, 2024. The only contributions received were from the Hoosiers for Jeff PAC – total of \$26,695)

Expenditures in question:

1. Galaxy – media services – 3 payments of \$5,071.66 each paid on 9/27, 9/29 and 9/30/23. Plus, an additional payment of \$8,946 paid on 12/4/23. Total paid \$24,160.98.
2. 11/2/23 – Engagement Strategies – payment of \$2,394.84 for “voter outreach”.

Question: If the only source of contributions received by Jeff Republicans PAC were from the Hoosiers for Jeffersonville PAC and there were only two companies who were paid with these funds (Galaxy and Engagement Strategies), why didn't the Hoosiers for Jeffersonville PAC pay these two expenses directly rather than setting up a separate PAC?

Also, note that the address for Jeff Republicans PAC is a post office box located at the UPS store in Jeffersonville. There was no payment made by Jeff Republicans PAC to pay for a post office box. The post office box # given for Jeff Republicans PAC is also the address for “MDL Strategies” which was paid by Hoosiers for Jeffersonville PAC on 10/16/23 in the amount of \$7,500 for “consulting fees”. MDL was also paid \$35,000 by the I'm for Mike Moore committee for “consulting fees”.

I'm for Mike Moore Committee – Michael Moore, chairperson; Judith VanGilder, treasurer 52 Arctic Springs, Jeffersonville, IN and PO Box 823, Jeffersonville, IN

Expenditures in question:

1. John Jones Auto – 1450 IN-60, Salem, IN – paid \$16326.75 for “vehicle”.

Why was a vehicle needed for this campaign when the mayor was running unopposed? What type of vehicle was purchased – year, make and model? Who was the vehicle titled to?

2. Amy Huffman – 944 E. 7th St., Jeffersonville, IN – paid \$5,000 on 4/18/23; 5/22/23 and 6/26/23. Plus paid \$7,500 on 7/31/23 --- total of \$22,500 for “consulting fees/campaign staff”.
3. Christy O’Neil – 7086 Plum Creek, Clarksville, IN – paid \$7,500 on 7/28/23 for “campaign staff”.

Note: Both Ms. Huffman and Ms. O’Neil are full-time employees of the City of Jeffersonville and work in the mayor’s office. If they were hired as “campaign staff”, they should be paid W-2 wages, subject to federal, state and FICA withholdings. The campaign would also have to pay the employer’s share of FICA tax. There is no indication on the campaign finance forms that payroll taxes were paid. Did these women receive a W-2? Did they receive a 1099? Was all their work performed outside of their normal city work hours?

4. MDL Strategies – 3310-4 E. 10th St. #359, Jeffersonville, IN – paid \$8,750 on 4/1/23, 5/1/23, 6/1/23 and 7/1/23 –total of \$35,000 for “consulting fees”.

Note: MDL Strategies also was paid \$7,500 on 7/31/23 by Hoosiers for Jeff PAC (see page 2). MDL Strategies was not found on the Secretary of State website and there is no street address listed, just a P.O. box.)

****In addition, federal law may impose a variety of reporting obligations on “Section 527 organizations” (tax-exempt political organizations). For example, although contributions to a political organization are generally tax exempt, investment of these funds and resulting interest income may result in tax liability. As a consequence, a political organization may be required to file IRS Form 1120 POL. In addition, some political committees may be required to file IRS Form 8871, Form 8872, and Form 990 (or 990EZ). It appears that there were odd amounts contributed by First Savings Bank to Hoosiers for Jeffersonville PAC in 2023 and 2024 which indicates that funds may have been invested with interest returns. *Did these campaigns file the proper tax forms with the IRS?***

Relevant Law and Indiana Codes

IC 3-5-2-7. “Political Action Committee” also refers to all campaign finance committees that are not candidate’s committees, regular party committees, legislative caucus committees, or an auxiliary party organization.

IC 3-9-1-12(g) A dissolution and transfer of funds does not relieve the committee or its members from civil or criminal liability.

IC 3-9-1-24 The treasurer of a committee shall obtain and keep receipted bills, canceled checks, or other proof of payment, stating the particulars for each expenditure made by or on behalf of a committee: 1) of more than \$25; and 2) for a small amount, if the aggregate amount of the expenditures to the same person during a year exceeds \$25. The treasurer shall preserve all receipted bills and accounts required to be kept by this section for: 1) three years; or 2) one year after the date of dissolution of the committee; whichever occurs first.

****Time is of the essence**

IC 3-9-3-4 Money received by a candidate or any committee as a contribution may not be used for primarily personal purposes by the

candidate, the committee, or by any other person except as described below. . . .

IC 3-9-4-13 Audits; investigations. The election division and each county election board shall make audits and field investigations from time to time with respect to reports and statements filed under this article and with respect to an alleged failure to file a report or statement required under this article. The election division may request the state board of accounts to assist in the performance of audits the election division considers necessary, and the state board of accounts may perform the audits that are requested.

IC 3-9-4-15 A member of the Commission, the co-directors of the Election Division (with the authorization of the Commission), or a member of a county election board may conduct a hearing or investigation, take evidence, and report back to the Commission or county election board for its consideration and action.

IC 3-9-4-16(a)(9) In addition to any other penalty imposed, a person who does any of the following is subject to a civil penalty under this section: . . . Commingles the funds of a committee with the personal funds of an officer, a member, or an associate of the committee.

IC 3-9-4-16(a)(10) In addition to any other penalty imposed, a person who does any of the following is subject to a civil penalty under this section: . . .
.Wrongfully using campaign contributions in violation of IC 3-9-3-4.

IC 3-14-1-13 A person who knowingly files a fraudulent report commits a Level 6 felony, and is subject to a \$10,000 fine, two and one-half years imprisonment, or both.

IC 3-14-1-16; IC 3-9-4-16; IC 3-9-4-17 A person who knowingly or intentionally violates IC 3-9-3-4 commits a Class A infraction and may be subject to a judgment of up to \$10,000 or a civil penalty of up to \$1,000 assessed by the Commission or the appropriate county election board.

IC 3-14-5-3. If the Commission or board determines that a felony or misdemeanor violation of the Campaign Finance Act may have occurred, the violation ***must*** be reported to the appropriate prosecuting attorney. The Commission or board may have the report transmitted to the grand jury of the county in which the violation was committed and present evidence concerning the violation to the grand jury.

IC 3-14-5-4; IC 3-6-5-32 A prosecuting attorney is responsible for prosecuting criminal violations of the Act and may file criminal charges following referral by a county election board.

IC 4-21.5 Election Commission and county election board campaign finance hearings are subject to the procedural requirements set forth in the Administrative Orders and Procedures Act (AOPA).

RE: I'm for Mike Moore Campaign

Inquiry: IC 3-9-2-4(7) identifies limitations on Corporate contributions. Several Corporations appear to have exceeded these amounts in 2023 for the *I'm for Mike Moore* campaign, according to the publicly available CFA-4's. There are likely others from prior years. An audit is requested, or interpretation of the codes.

IC 3-9-2-4(7) Corporations or labor organizations; limitation on contributions; During a year a corporation or labor organization may not make total contributions in excess of: . . . (7) an aggregate of two thousand dollars (\$2,000) apportioned in any manner among all candidates for school board offices and local offices; . . .

The following corporations appear to have made contributions in excess of the allowable amount per IC 3-9-2-4(7). LLC's may be excluded, depending on the IC interpretation of Corporation:

Clark County Election Board Inquiry/Complaint

RE: Hoosiers for Jeffersonville PAC

Inquiry: IC 3-9-2-4(7) puts limitations on how much a Corporation can contribute to a local candidate and IC 3-9-2-5(c) states the contribution must be designated for disbursement to a specific candidate or committee. The Hoosiers for Jeffersonville PAC lists Corporate contributions without designation to any particular candidate, making it impossible to know if they have violated the limitations on contributions in IC 3-9-2-4(7). An audit is requested, or interpretation of the code.

IC 3-9-2-4(7) Corporations or labor organizations; limitation on contributions . . . an aggregate of two thousand dollars (\$2,000) apportioned in any manner among all candidates for school board offices and local offices;

IC 3-9-2-5(c) Contributions or donations to specific candidate or committee . . . A corporation or labor organization may make a contribution to a political action committee if the contribution:

- (1) does not exceed any of the limits prescribed under section 4 of this chapter; and**
- (2) is designated for disbursement to a specific candidate or committee listed under section 4 of this chapter.**

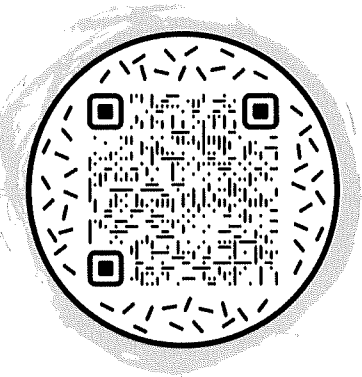

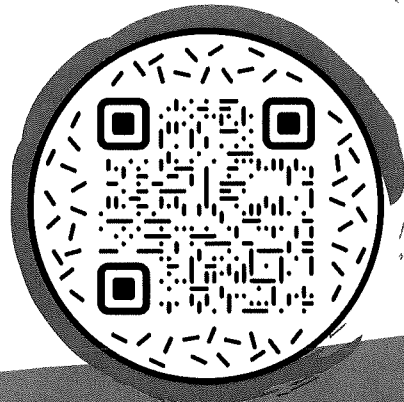

You can also meet this requirement by submitting proof of residence with this application or anytime up until election day. Proof of residence can be met by submitting either:

- (1) a COPY of your current and valid photo identification or
- (2) a current utility bill, bank statement, government check, paycheck, or government document that shows your name and address at the address you provided on this application. Please do not send originals. Cover any account information with a permanent marker.

FILL IN ALL APPLICABLE BOXES IN BLUE OR BLACK INK. DO NOT FAX OR EMAIL FORM AFTER COMPLETING IT.

Mail or hand deliver the completed application to your county registration office (addresses on reverse side) or the Indiana Election Division.

Box 4: Residence Address Print the address where you live. If your address is a rural route, include the box number. If your residence has no address or street number, write a short description of its location in Box 4 or attach a map.

Interested in politics, government or current events?
Want to miss a day of school and get paid for it?



Lucky for you, high school 16 and 17-year-olds are allowed to work at polling places on Election Day in the Hoosier Hall Pass poll worker recruitment program. You are not old enough to vote, but old enough to participate in the *Hoosier Hall Pass* program.

The Hoosier Hall Pass program enables 16 and 17-year-old students to experience Election Day by providing an opportunity to learn about democracy in action, becoming involved in your community and helping to support free and fair elections in Indiana.

In addition to reading about democracy in your government textbooks or seeing posts in your social media feed, you will take part in the political process and ensure counties have sufficient poll workers to serve the needs of voters.

What will I do as a poll worker?

1. Attend a short training session to learn how to be a poll worker.
2. Set up the polling place.
3. Help voters and explain how to cast a ballot.
4. Restore the polling place to its original condition and return the election supplies once the day is done.
5. Earn some extra cash.



PROGRAM DETAILS

Do I qualify to participate in Hoosier Hall Pass?

To work the polls on Election Day, you must meet the following requirements:

The individual is 16 or 17-years of age.

The individual is a citizen of the United States and a resident of the county in which they would work on Election Day.

The individual has the written approval of their principal or, if the student is educated at home, the approval of the individual responsible for the education of the student.

The individual has the approval of their parent or guardian.

The individual must satisfactorily complete any training required by the county election board.

The individual must serve in accordance with normal State of Indiana poll worker statutes.

The individual must have at least a 3.0 grade point average on a 4.0 scale.
