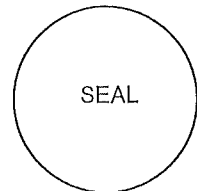

My friend, Alex who is also visually impaired successfully voted in Clarksville, Indiana nearby. I am excited to vote in the fall in November. Thank you for your consideration. They were not trained to operate the unit.

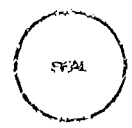

We are writing in reference to a HAVA grievance filed by Rasheedah Kenner on August 27, 2024 (please see attached).

We are required to determine that, if the facts alleged in the complaint by Ms. Kenner are true, did a violation of the Title III of the Help America Vote Act (HAVA) occur. This HAVA grievance was properly executed and sworn to as required by IC 3-6-4.5-7.

We respectfully request that the Clerk's Office and the County Election Board provide the Election Division with any information available regarding the allegation that an accessible voting system was not available to voters with disabilities at her voting location and whether individuals assigned to work at the voting location were trained to set-up the accessible voting system and assist a voter with disabilities to use those features that would allow the voter to vote privately and independently.
