

The Crawford County Commissioners met in Regular Session on July 8, 2025, at 4:00PM. The members were present: Crecelius, Ingle, and Dale. Also in attendance was Chief Deputy Phelps and Attorney Gordon Ingle. Present via phone was Auditor Marples.

**Highway Department Superintendent Bender** – Senator Schmitt requested to name a bridge on I 64 after one of the engineers who designed it. Requested name is Dale Gabby Workman Memorial Bridge. Located on I64 between English and Carefree exit. Motion to approve made by Crecelius, seconded by Ingle, Dale agreed. Motion approved with a vote of 3-0.

**Crawford County Security Company Jessica Starr** – Update on county insurance renewal. Sent EMC for their audit. In good standing. Deadline is no later than 8/17/2025.

Spoke about English Fire Protection District vacancy. Dale Roll's Son Christian filled in up to July 1, 2025. He works out of town and can't get into town until later in the day. DLGF wants to meet during day. Voted for Don Bernham to take spot for the next 4 years. Motion to approve made by Ingle, seconded by Crecelius, Dale agreed. Motion approved with a vote of 3-0.

**Ellen Meyers** - Discussion regarding dogs and serious issues with attacks and fear within the town. Thanks to the commissioners for helping with emergencies. Commissioner Crecelius stated they called an emergency situation and got 2 dogs. There are issues with remainder of the dogs attacking an 85-year-old man. It is a responsibility of the town to take care of this but commissioners did step in.

**Highway Department Superintendent Bender** – Unofficial detour across West Fork Road. INDOT will reimburse the county similar to Patoka School Road. Motion to approve MOU on West Fork Road made by Crecelius, seconded by Ingle, Dale agreed. Motion approved with a vote of 3-0.

MOU to cover Wyandotte Cave Road and Knights road. Official Detour. State responsible for bridge on I64. Contacted Seymour District and agreed after bridge completed INDOT will negotiate payment. Motion to approve made by Ingle, seconded by Crecelius, Dale agreed. Motion approved with a vote of 3-0.

**Attorney Ingle** – Ordinance to rename right of way off of State Road 66 to Barron Lane. Private Right of way. Named after young man who passed of childhood diabetes. Recommends Commissioners to approve Ordinance 07-08-2025. Motion to approve made by Crecelius, seconded by Ingle, Dale agreed. Motion approved with a vote of 3-0.

**Payroll dockets** – 6/6/2025, 6/20/2025, 6/23/2025. Motion to approve made by Crecelius, seconded by Ingle, Dale agreed. Motion approved with a vote of 3-0.

**Minutes** – 6/10/2025, 6/17/2025, and 6/27/2025. Motion to approve made by Ingle, seconded by Crecelius, Dale agreed. Motion approved with a vote of 3-0.

**Claims Dockets** – 6/17/2025 to 7/8/2025. Motion to approve made by Crecelius, seconded by Ingle, Dale agreed. Motion approved with a vote of 3-0.

**EMS Director Tim Farris** – Give attorney to review agreement with MEDPRO Disposal. To get rid of medical waste. \$390 per year. Stop by every 3 months. It is \$125 per container if they need more. They will take any narcotics and dispose of them. Would like to get back with them by next meeting.
