FCCC Business

- I. **Welcome** – Presentation by Director Daraius Randelia.
- II. **Transfer Approvals** - None
- III. **New Business.**
 - a. There are two open positions currently, a supervision officer and a reentry position. Only one is going to be filled at present.
 - b. They expect to lose some DOC funding which is happening across the State.
 - c. They would like to add a Juvenile Position which is paid for through the county budget but will have to go through approval process with county.
 - d. If they eliminate the Cognitive Behavioral Program (due to limited referrals), they could use that position's funding to fund adult supervision. Also, would refer to other local community corrections such as Clark County for those services.
 - e. There is also a challenge and in filling positions due to pay scale not as competitive. Will need to reconvene the Personnel Needs committee.
- IV. **FCCC Personnel Needs Assessment Committee report (special committee)** – Judge Stiller asks for a meeting invite be sent out to the Personnel Needs Assessment Committee to coordinate a meeting date to include Matt Millies, who is new

JRAC Business

- I. **Spotlight on Local Resource - Final Reports from 2025 Grant Recipients** – these reports will also be shared with the Commissioners.
 - a. **Jacob's Well – Kevin and Barbara Williams – and Reallocation of funds request** – Jacob's Well founders report on the use of grant funds, which include 223 hours of trauma informed counseling, 26 hours of counseling for children, 6 group sessions, staff training, and new equipment. They are requesting to continue funding through 2026 and to reallocate \$25,840.69 for EDMR training, Family Systems training, and to provide child care. Moon motions to approve. Bush seconds. The Judges abstain. The motion passes unanimously. See attached voting form. Judge Stiller will amend the agreement to extend it through December 31, 2026.

- b. **Genesis House for Women – Meghan Stockdale** - 219 women have been through their doors. 28% of program graduates are from Floyd County. They have an 89% success rate, which means no new charges and closing out of old charges, for graduates. 15% of their current residents are from Floyd County. New construction has begun to increase the number of beds from 30 to 46 and to add transitional housing. They have received a grant from the Southern Indiana Health Association.
- c. **Breakaway Recovery – Anna Craven** – Breakaway is a 14 bed facility that provides comprehensive peer recovery support and transportation. This grant extends through 2026. They are still looking for a funding source to continue the program past 2026.

II. Committee Reports

- a. **Opioid Funds and Finance Committee** (standing committee) – Stiller Chair – Judge Stiller reminds everyone that Opioid funds will taper as the program continues, and that they only want to assign funds that the county has in its possession. Further financial information to be provided at next meeting after conferring with auditor.
- b. **Juvenile Initiatives/All IN (work group)**–Magistrate Flanigan lead –
 - i. The Big Brother Big Sister program is going to the School Board to request permission for the mentor program to be allowed back into Hazlewood.
 - ii. Daniel Molson, Juvenile Probation Officer, received money to start the Growth Project, which teaches children resilience.
 - iii. **2027 Funding request – Juvenile Probation Liason** – Requesting \$247,900 in opioid funding to continue the School Liaison program through 2029. Matt Millies motions to fund the Juvenile Probation Attendance Liaison Position and Program in the amount of \$247,900 through December 31, 2029 assuming opioid funds are available, with verification of funds to be determined in July. Becky Gardenour seconds the motion. The Judges abstain. The motion passes unanimously. See attached voting form.
- c. **JRAC MH and Addiction Committee** (standing committee), Judge Stiller, chair
Discuss dissolving this committee and monthly meetings for the following reasons:
 - a) Committee was primarily created for criminal justice reformation which has evolved and many of the changes implemented have now become institutional with regular communication and meetings between criminal justice partners occurring as needed.
 - b) Since this committee was originally formed, we have created many other committees to do the work as needs have evolved.
 - c) We expanded quarterly meeting to two hours, allowing us more productivity with the full board and that has worked well.
 - d) Anticipated need for additional committee/work groups in the near future.
 - e) We will call special meetings as needed.Judge Stiller outlines the reasons for disbanding the Mental Health and Addiction Committee, and states that disbanding it now will not prevent it from being reformed in the future. Judge Stiller asks for any input or objections about disbanding. There are no objections.
- d. **Faith Organization Outreach** – (standing committee) – Matt Lorch, Chair – Matt Lorch requests that anyone that knows of any faith based leaders that provide services have those leaders reach out to him, with the goal being to include the organizations in next year's JRAC summit and to include them in the resource inventory. He is working on a spreadsheet and making a plan for communication pathways with these entities.

III. New Business

- a. **JRAC Survey response team needed** – All Indiana JRACs have been requested to fill out an Annual Survey Report. Judge Stiller asks that anyone who would like to help or give feedback send her an email.
- b. Review IOJA Behavioral Health Committee Report and Recommendations – Judge Stiller explains the IOJA Behavioral Health Committee Report and Recommendations.
- c. Outreach to other Southern Indiana JRACs – Judge Stiller is working on outreach with other JRACs, and is in communication with other area JRAC Chairs.

- IV. Adjournment – Webster motions to adjourn. Beckwith seconds the motion. The motion passes unanimously. Meeting adjourned at 1:19 PM.
