Justice Christopher M. Goff

Justice Goff has worked in Indiana's criminal justice system for nearly 30 years, serving as a trial and appellate advocate, as a trial judge, and as an Associate Justice of the Indiana Supreme Court. He currently serves as Chair of the Indiana Justice Reinvestment Advisory Council, Chair-Elect of the Appellate Judges' Conference of the American Bar Association, and as an adjunct professor of law at IU McKinney School of Law. As a trial judge, he established three certified problem-solving courts. He was a member of the National Judicial Task Force to Improve State Courts' Response to Mental Illness. He is the author of a one-volume treatise on Indiana Criminal Law and Procedure. He has also written on community-based supervision and treatment. Justice Goff is a graduate of Ball State University, IU Maurer School of Law, and Duke Law School.
