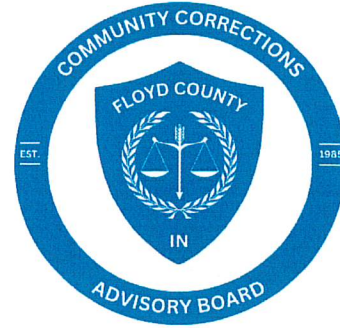




Minutes

- III. Approval of July 14, 2025 Minutes – Motion by Bush. Second by Lorch. Approved unanimously - and Amendment of April 14, 2025 Minutes – Motion by Bush. Second by Webster. Approved unanimously.

- V. Proposed 2026 Meeting schedule – Judge Stiller will be sending out a proposed schedule. On months when the FCCC-JRAC has a quarterly meeting, the Mental Health and Addiction Subcommittee will not meet that month.

FCCC Business

- I. Welcome and Introduction of Ty Robbins, Program Director, IDOC
 - a. IDOC has had their funding cut for the 2026-2027 biennium.
 - b. Provides guidance on use of grant funds.
 - c. Helps counties use evidence-based practices.
- II. Transfer Approvals – none
 - a. Darius is going to meet with the Floyd County Auditor to make certain that all funds are spent.
- III. New Business
 - a. Proposed collection of fee for juvenile HD monitors from county \$15 p/day –
 - i. This fee used to be higher, but Daraius agreed to pause the fee, due to concerns about a Floyd County entity billing another Floyd County entity, and the nature of the fee being nebulous in the past. The \$15 p/day fee is the same as is charged for adult HD monitors, and will cover the costs of administering the program. Judge Stiller motions to approve the fee increase. Second by Bush. Approved unanimously.

- b. Update on cost of monitors
 - i. Total Court Services is reducing what they charge for the monitors to \$3.61, down from \$3.95.
 - c. Grant to pay for radios for surveillance officers from Community Foundation of SI
 - i. The grant is for radios so that staff can call for help in situations where they may not have reliable cell phone service.

 - ii. The Fair Chance Boot Camp is a 3-week long readiness and life skills program. A pilot program is in the Clark County jail. The goal of the program is to help people be employable. They are looking to expand this program into all six county jails in the area, would like to offer bimonthly cohorts in the career center, and are looking for grants, partnerships, co-case management, and connections with employers open to fair hiring practices.
