Roger Jeffers stated the Parks Department decided not to pursue Cum Cap Tax at this time due to time constraints. He stated that he learned from the Reedy Group that this tax is not a new tax and it is part of existing tax that would be redistributed. It would not result in higher taxes.

Brad Stiegel shared he has been in contact with the DLGF. The Parks Cum Cap Tax would be inside the Levy and would not be a new tax. It would not increase taxes or increase revenue for the county. It would decrease other funds to increase Parks.

Mr. Jeffers stated they are asking for a funding source for this year and next.

He stated he would like to plan a tour of all the parks with the Council, Commissioners and Parks Board later this year. They would have a list of improvements that they would like to make.

Brad Stiegel stated that it would be best to do the tour before budget time so it could be budgeted for 2022.

Dale Bagshaw challenged the Council if they have the courage to cut other budgets to fund the Parks. He thinks parks are very important.

##### **5. FLOYD COUNTY TREASURER– STEVE BURKS (NB#5)**

###### **RESOLUTION 2021-04 AMENDMENT OF ORDINANCE 2019-03 ESTABLISHING THE REMOVAL OF PENALTIES**

Brad Stiegel stated the Hospital Fund has 2.1 million dollars left in it after the payoff of the Jail. The Commissioners and the Council will be splitting the money 50/50 at the next Council meeting. It will need to be advertised before appropriating.

Adam Roberts asked where they stood on the City of New Albany payment for elections. Denise Konkle stated that she asked Jacqueline Wenning for a spreadsheet of the expenses so they can send the City the invoices of expenses for their portion of the elections. Jacqueline Wenning stated she has the information and will complete the spreadsheet in the next couple weeks.




## **PUBLIC**






