Denise Konkle stated she calculated what they would need to pay out of the Employee Benefit fund for vacation buyouts for everyone except the ones that Don Lopp had already budgeted for. They need to appropriate \$84,594.91 into the payout line.

Don Lopp stated the County is attempting to get a Landmark Conservation Grant through the Department of Natural Resources for the proposed 227-acre park in Georgetown Township.

c. Discussion on subcommittee for Renovation and Building Projects
Connie Moon nominated herself, Danny Short and Dale Bagshaw to be on the committee. Seconded by Denise Konkle. Motion passed unanimously.

Motion for Tony Toran, Connie Moon and Danny Short to serve on the transparency Committee. Moved by Denise Konkle. Seconded by Danny Short. Motion passed unanimously.

#### **Committee Reports**

Danny Short stated he has been working with Northside Christian Church, New Albany Little League and Don Lopp concerning the parking situation at the Little League Park. Northside has agreed to sell 2.2 acres to Little League for \$1.00. The Commissioners, according to Tim Kamer, have agreed to put \$250,000.00 that was set aside for paving the north lot toward the paving cost of the new area. Students at Prosser will be involved in excavating and local firms are discounting services. He asked the Council to contribute toward the engineering cost of \$100,000.00. The total project will be approximately \$700,000.00. Once the work is completed, Little League will be responsible for maintaining the parking lot.

Adam Roberts stated there were 23 applicants for the Legacy Foundation Grants. He also, asked the members of Council to utilize the County issued hardware.

Denise Konkle stated the County has made the last payment to YMCA, fulfilling their commitment.

Denise Konkle stated the Reedy Group sent out the 2023 budget timetable.
