Tim Berry from Crowe said they received a call from S&P wanting to review the bond rating for the County. He thanked Commissioner, Al Knable; Councilman, Danny Short; Don Lopp and Diana Topping for getting information needed in late November for S&P. They came back at the end of January to affirm Floyd County's ratings as an A and to affirm that on a stable basis. The economic outlook in Floyd County remains strong. They commended the actions that the Council has made to stabilize LIT income and LIT revenues and the outlook looks good moving forward. He thanked Auditor, Diana Topping, for her extra efforts to get the back up documentation and information to provide to them.

Mr. Berry said he will come back in March with bond parameters for the Health Department Building. The cost of the building is \$2.2 million. Some money has been set aside for remodeling and renovation costs.

He said the County Road Department has put some fill in. The Engineering Consultant wants to see the water raise and go back down to see what the impact of that was before they are willing to open the bridge back up.
