ORDINANCE NO. FC-85-2

An Ordinance amending an Ordinance No. FC-85-1.

WHEREAS, The Board of Commissioners of the County of Floyd did on the 4th day of February, 1985 adopted Ordinance No. FC-85-1, the same being entitled "Economic and Industrial Development Ordinance of 1985"; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Floyd is presently desirous of amending Ordinance No. FC-85-1 in the particulars as hereinafter set forth.

NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED, that Ordinance No. FC-85-1 be, and the same hereby is amended by the addition thereto of the following Section:

Section 9. Low and Moderate Income Benefit.

- A. "The Economic Development Revolving Loan Fund Board" and the Board of County Commissioners during application review shall make a good faith effort to assure the maximum achieveable benefit to low and moderate income persons through job creation as a result of loan approval activity under this program.
- B. During review of each loan application the RLF Board shall assure that at least 75% of the total jobs created, through the required job creation assurance portion of the application, be for low and moderate income persons.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that Section 9 and 10 of the original Ordinance No. FC-85-1 be and hereby are renumbered, respectively Section 10 and Section 11.
