

AN ORDINANCE VACATING PUBLIC USE OF
TUCKER ROAD AND PART OF PLAT NO. 73

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of the County of Floyd, Indiana, pursuant to I.C. 36-7-3-12, that:

SECTION 1. Public use of the right-of-way commonly known as Tucker Road, in Floyd County, Indiana, more fully described as follows, to-wit:

A roadway twenty feet, more or less, wide, commonly known as Tucker Road, in Floyd County, Indiana, and being a part of Fractional Section 14, Township 2 South, Range 6 East and a part of Plat No. 73, the western boundary of which is described as follows:

Commencing at an iron pin at the Northeast corner of Lot No. 23 of said Plat No. 73, thence South with the westerly line of an eighty-foot-wide railroad right-of-way 3326.47 feet, more or less, to the northerly line of Hausfeldt Lane

be and the same hereby is vacated.

SECTION 2. Public use of that portion of Plat No. 73 of Fractional Section Fourteen (14) in Township Two (2) South of Range Six (6) East, of the Floyd County, Indiana, records, consisting of a Forty (40)-foot strip of land bounded by lots 27 and 20 on the north and lots 28 and 19 on the south and designated as "B" on said Plat, be and the same hereby is vacated.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Board of Commissioners of the County of Floyd, Indiana, and signed by the Board.
