

FLOYD COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 1991-4

An ordinance requiring permits for those who shall provide solid waste disposal service.

1. DEFINITIONS:

A. The term "Board" shall refer to and mean the Board of Commissioners of the County of Floyd, Indiana.

B. The term "solid waste" shall mean all describable and nondescribable solid and semisolid waste, except human sewage and its products, but including garbage, rubbish, ashes, dead animals, and solid commercial, industrial and institutional waste.

C. The term "solid waste disposal service" shall refer to and include any person, persons, or corporations who, for a consideration, shall offer to remove solid waste from any residence, apartment, condominium, business, or industry in Floyd County, Indiana.

2. No person, firm, or corporation shall operate a solid waste disposal service in Floyd County, Indiana, without first obtaining a nonexclusive permit from the Board, PROVIDED, no city or town in Floyd County, Indiana, which provides solid waste disposal service shall be required to obtain a permit hereunder.

3. For a permit to be issued under the terms of this ordinance there is hereby established an annual fee of \$500.00 for each permit. The foregoing, notwithstanding, a permit fee of \$250.00 shall be assessed for calendar year 1991, with permits to be obtained not later than July 1, 1991, PROVIDED, no permit fee shall be charged an applicant for a calendar year 1991 permit if the applicant is the holder of a valid and current Solid Waste Disposal Permit issued by Clark County, Indiana.


4. The Board shall, from time to time, establish rules and regulations pertaining to solid waste and its disposal, which rules and regulations, upon their adoption, shall be deemed a part of this ordinance.

5. Any person, firm or corporation violating the terms and provisions of this ordinance shall be fined not less than \$25.00 nor more than \$2500.00. For purposes of this ordinance, each day that a violation shall continue shall be deemed a separate offense hereunder.

6. Any person, firm, or corporation who shall be required to obtain a permit hereunder but who shall fail to apply therefor on or before January 15th of each calendar year shall be assessed a late application fee of \$150.00, which late application fee shall be in addition to any fine which may be assessed for a violation of the terms and provisions of this ordinance.

7. The ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its adoption and publication as required by statute, but not sooner than the first day of June, 1991.
