

FLOYD COUNTY ORDINANCE 1992- 8

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE COLLECTION OF CERTAIN FEES  
BY THE FLOYD COUNTY CLERK

WHEREAS, as a service to the public, the Floyd County Clerk presently mails child support checks to the Custodial Parent utilizing stamped-addressed envelopes furnished for that purpose; and

WHEREAS, the number of persons utilizing this service has increased to the extent that the processing, storage and maintenance of these envelopes has become a burden upon the staff and facilities of the Floyd County Clerk; and

WHEREAS, the Floyd County Clerk has suggested that the continuation of this service will require the utilization of official envelopes furnished by Floyd County, Indiana and postage provided at public expense; and

WHEREAS, the Floyd County Clerk has proposed the imposition of a reasonable user fee to defray the cost of providing this service, the same to be paid and satisfied by those persons utilizing or benefiting from this service; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Floyd is empowered by applicable provisions of Title 36 of the Indiana Code to authorize the imposition of reasonable fees for services rendered by County Officials and their offices, and the Board, by this ordinance, is desirous of authorizing the Floyd County Clerk to levy and collect a reasonable fee for the service of mailing child support payments to the Custodial Parent.

NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED, That the Floyd County Clerk be, and hereby is, authorized to collect, in advance, the following fees for services rendered and expenses incurred in the mailing of child support payments to the Custodial Parent:

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that all sums collected under and pursuant to this ordinance shall be remitted by the Floyd County Clerk for deposit in the General Fund of Floyd County and appropriation or other disposition by order of the Floyd County Council.
