

FLOYD COUNTY ORDINANCE 1993- 7
AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE FLOYD COUNTY AUDITOR
TO COLLECT A FEE FOR FURNISHING COPIES

WHEREAS, from time to time, the Floyd County Auditor is requested to furnish copies of documents and records to members of the public; and

WHEREAS, the cost of providing this service is presently borne and assumed by all taxpayers of Floyd County, but without regard to direct benefit derived thereby; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of I.C. 36-1-3-8(6), the Board of Commissioners of the County of Floyd is empowered to establish as service charge or user fee for the service rendered by the Floyd County Auditor, to the extent that the fee for the service rendered does not exceed the estimated cost of providing same; and

WHEREAS, the Floyd County Auditor has petitioned the Board of Commissioners of the County of Floyd to enact an ordinance permitting the assessment of a fee of 25 cents per page for copies of documents and records furnished to members of the public; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Floyd has determined that such fee is not greater than that reasonably related to the reasonable and just rate and charge for the service to be rendered by the Floyd County Auditor.

NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED that the Floyd County Auditor be, and she hereby is, authorized and directed to levy and collect a fee of 25 cents per page for copies of records and documents furnished and provided to members of the public.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED That the fees collected pursuant to this ordinance shall be remitted at least monthly to the Treasurer of Floyd County for deposit in the General Fund of Floyd County.
