

FLOYD COUNTY ORDINANCE 2000-III
AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FLOYD COUNTY PERSONNEL POLICIES

WHEREAS, on the 16th day of August, 1994 and the 25th day of August, 1994, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Floyd and the Floyd County Council, respectively, approved certain personnel policies governing conditions of employment, benefits, and related matters; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Floyd, with the concurrence of the Floyd County Council is desirous of amending said policies in the manner as hereinafter set forth.

NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, that Section 3.11 of the Floyd County Personnel Policies, the same being entitled OVERTIME, be, and the same hereby is amended by the deletion therefrom of the following language:

Overtime Pay: Overtime pay shall be figured at 1 1/2 times the regular hourly pay rate.

and by the substitution therefor of the following language:

Overtime Pay: Overtime pay shall be computed at the rate of one and one-half (1.5) times the 'regular rate' of pay at which the employee is actually employed, as such regular rate is defined by the Fair Labor Standards Act (29 USC 201, et seq.), as amended from time to time, together with those regulations and directives duly adopted and pertaining thereto.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its endorsement by the Floyd County Council.
