

FLOYD COUNTY ORDINANCE 2000- VI

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PAYMENT OF MEMBERSHIP DUES
IN CERTAIN LOCAL, REGIONAL, STATE, AND NATIONAL ASSOCIATIONS
OF A CIVIC, EDUCATIONAL, OR GOVERNMENTAL NATURE

WHEREAS, the State Board of Accounts has determined that no express statutory authority exists for the payment of dues or related expenses from public funds for membership in professional organizations or in local, regional, state, or national associations of a civic, educational or governmental nature; and

WHEREAS, the State Board of Accounts has recommended that, in the absence of such express authority, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Floyd may, nevertheless, create such authority through the adoption of an Ordinance pursuant to the provisions of I.C. 36-1-3, et seq; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Floyd is desirous of adopting this ordinance authorizing, subject to appropriation by the Floyd County Council, the expenditure of public funds for membership in certain professional, civic, educational, or governmental entities, organizations, or associations, and for the payment of reasonable expenses related to such membership.

NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED, that subject to the approval of the Board of Commissioners of the County of Floyd, from time to time, and an appropriation by the Floyd County Council, public funds may be used for payment of membership dues assessed by professional organizations and/or local, regional, state, or national associations of a civic, educational or governmental nature, together with those reasonable expenses related to membership and participation therein.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that this ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage.
