

FLOYD COUNTY ORDINANCE 2002-VIII

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FLOYD COUNTY CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN

WHEREAS, by Floyd County Ordinance 2000-14, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Floyd duly adopted, pursuant to the provisions of I.C. 6-3.5-7-15, a Capital Improvement Plan encompassing the period from January 1, 2001 to December 31, 2002; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Floyd is desirous of amending said Plan in the particulars as hereinafter set forth.

NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED, that the Floyd County Capital Improvement Plan dated the 1st day of January, 2001, be, and the same hereby is amended to permit the expenditure of CEDIT revenues for the following purposes, which expenditures shall, however, be subject to appropriation by the Floyd County Council:

- a. A sum not to exceed \$4,480.00 for the repair, maintenance, and improvement of the medical dispensary located in the Criminal Justice Center;
- b. A sum not to exceed \$4,400.00 for painting unfinished areas within the Criminal Justice Center;
- c. A sum not to exceed \$758.00 for to replace the carpeting and paint the offices of the Veteran's Service Officer located in the City-County Building; and,
- d. ~~A sum not to exceed \$1,275.00 for the construction of a counter within the offices of the Alcohol and Drug program located in the City-County Building.~~

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that two copies of the Floyd County Capital Improvement Plan, as amended by this Ordinance, shall be kept on file in the office of the Floyd County Auditor for public inspection.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that this ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage.
