FLOYD COUNTY ORDINANCE 2004- XII

AN ORDINANCE CREATING A NON-REVERTING FUND FOR FLOYD COUNTY COMMUNITY CORRECTIONS

WHEREAS, Floyd County Community Corrections has applied for an Indiana Criminal Justice Grant to be used in the manner and for the purposes set forth in the grant application; and

WHEREAS, a condition for the receipt of grant funds is the establishment of a separate trust fund for the deposit and disbursement of grant revenues; and

WHEREAS, the State Board of Accounts has confirmed in Volume No. 283 of the County Bulletin, January, 1991, that the Board of Commissioners of the County of Floyd, acting pursuant to the provisions of IC 36-1-3, et seq., is empowered to create, by ordinance, such funds deemed necessary for the effective operation of government as to local affairs.

NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED that a non-reverting fund, to be known as the Floyd County Juvenile Evaluation Fund, be, and the same hereby is created, with said fund to be subject to the following terms and conditions:

- (1) REVENUE: Revenues received upon grant funding shall be deposited in the Fund, with the same to be expended only for grant purposes.
- (2) NON-REVERSION: The fund hereby created shall be non-reverting from year to year.
