

FLOYD COUNTY ORDINANCE FCO 2009- XI

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. FCO-XVII, AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING RATES AND CHARGES FOR SERVICES RENDERED BY THE FLOYD COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners for the County of Floyd is empowered, pursuant to the provisions of I.C. 36-1-3, et seq., to establish reasonable rates, charges and fees for governmental services provided to the public; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners for the County of Floyd adopted Ordinance No. XVII on August 21, 2001 establishing a schedule of fees for services rendered to the public by the Floyd County Health Department; and

WHEREAS, the Floyd County Health Department has requested an increase to some of the fees and charges for the medical and environmental services provided by the department, more particularly the fees for vital records; and

WHEREAS, the Floyd County Health Department has requested the following fees and charges for vital records:

Birth Certificates	\$10.00 each copy
Death Certificates	\$10.00 each copy
Genealogy search	\$10.00 per name

WHEREAS, upon review, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Floyd has determined that the above fees and charges do not exceed the administrative cost of those regulatory powers to be exercised or the cost of the services to be provided by the Department; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Floyd is desirous of adopting by this Ordinance the fees to be charged by the Department for services rendered.

NOW THEREFORE:


BE IT ORDAINED, that the fees and charges set forth above are, adopted and established as the fees and charges to be levied and imposed for the various services to be rendered and performed by the Floyd County health Department, with such fees and charges, upon collection and receipt, to be deposited by the Department as required by law.

BE IT FUTHER ORDAINED, that all provisions of all previous ordinances adopted for the purpose of establishing rates and charges for services to be rendered and performed by the Floyd County Health Department not specifically contradicted herein shall remain in full force and effect.


BE IT FUTHER ORDAINED, that this ordinance shall be in full force and effect after the date of its adoption, being the 6th day of October, 2009.




