An Ordinance for Designating Local Travel Advisories

WHERE AS, IC 10-14-3-29.5 (c) states A “warning” level travel advisory may be issued only after a local disaster emergency is declared under section 29 of this chapter.


WHEREFORE, it is ordered, adjudged and decreed that if a local disaster emergency is declared under IC 10-14-3-29, pursuant to IC 10-14-3-29.5 (a)(3), a “warning” is issued, travel may be restricted to emergency management personnel only. During a “warning” local travel advisory, individuals are directed to:

- (A) refrain from all travel;
 - (B) comply with necessary emergency measures;
 - (C) cooperate with public officials and disaster services forces in executing emergency operations plans; and
 - (D) obey and comply with the lawful directions of properly identified officers.
- Further and more specific restrictions, including parking restrictions, may be included in a “warning” local travel advisory.
