

FLOYD COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. VII

AN ORDINANCE PERMITTING FORMER AND RETIRED SHERIFFS
TO CARRY POLICE FIREARMS

WHEREAS, Ind. Code § 35-47-11.1-4 allows local governments to enact and enforce regulations pertaining to firearms, ammunition, or firearm accessories issued to or used by law enforcement officers in the course of their official duties, and

WHEREAS, Floyd County has resolved and determined that it is in the public interest to allow its former and retired sheriffs to be permitted to keep and use their police firearms,

IT IS THEREFORE ORDAINED that:

1. Former and retired sheriffs of Floyd County are hereby allowed to retain their police handguns, and reasonable replacements for their police handguns, for their personal use and to carry without further permits or other applications.
2. This Ordinance does not operate to allow any person to carry a firearm if they are otherwise prohibited from carrying the same by any Federal, state, or other law.
