Whereas, the Floyd County Board of Commissioners met on October 17, 2017, on this matter pursuant to IC 36-7-4-600 series




NOW, THEREFORE,


BE IT ORDAINED that Floyd County Board of Commissioners hereby amends the Floyd County Ordinance 2006-6 with the language attached in Exhibit A.

Exhibit A

3.06 Ordinance Revision

A legal nonconforming structure which is damaged or destroyed by fire, flood, wind, earthquake or other calamity or act of God may be restored and the occupancy or use of such building, structure, or part thereof which existed at the time of such destruction may be continued or resumed, provided that such restoration is started within a period of 1 year of destruction and is diligently prosecuted to completion.
