

ORDINANCE NO. FCO 2018-13

**AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH THE  
FLOYD COUNTY COMMISSIONERS JURISDICTION OVER THE JAIL  
PROJECT**

WHEREAS, Floyd County (the "County") has jurisdiction over the Floyd County Jail pursuant to IC 36-2-2-24; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to IC 36-2-2-24, the Floyd County Commissioners and the Floyd County Council approved, funded, and entered into contracts for a jail renovation project to bring the jail up to statutory and constitutional standards; and

WHEREAS, the Floyd County Commissioners are exercising their statutory power under IC 36-2-2-24 and IC 36-1-3; and

WHEREAS, the Floyd County Commissioners are authorizing the Contractors to proceed with construction pursuant to their contracts; and

WHEREAS, the Floyd County Commissioners appoint and direct the Floyd County Building Department to issue any permits deemed necessary for the jail project.

THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Floyd County Commissioners that:

Section 1. The Floyd County Commissioners determined that Floyd County has sole jurisdiction to approve, fund, contract, and manage all aspects of the jail project at the City-County Building.

Section 2. The Floyd County Commissioners hereby approve and direct the Contractors for the jail project to proceed with the construction pursuant to their contracts.

Section 3. The Floyd County Commissioners direct the Floyd County Building Department to issue any permits deemed necessary for the jail project.

Section 4. This Ordinance takes effect upon passage.


