CORRECTIONS READINESS FOR RE-ENTRY, COMMUNITY CORRECTIONS, PROBATION

TO BE KNOWN AS

COMMUNITY CORRECTIONS PARTNERS FUND

Whereas, the Floyd County Board of Commissioners met on May 17, 2022 on the matter pursuant to establishing a non-reverting (yet appropriating) fund for the Floyd County IDOC Grant Partners — as defined above. The Floyd County Partners receive IDOC Grant funds, however, opportunities have been identified by other Funding sources. To ensure clarity, identity, and separation of funding, the Grant Partners are requesting a unique HOME RULED fund to house monies from other funding sources, including contractual agreements with funding from other Grant sources.

Whereas, the Board understands that the Floyd County Grant Partners are desirous of establishing this fund in accordance to the directions and guidance of State Board of Accounts. All monies will be receipted into the Fund. Appropriations will be submitted to the Floyd County Council. The Auditor will establish the Home-Ruled Fund Number for County records and oversee compliance to SBOA requirements.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED that the Floyd County Board of Commissioners set up a NON-Reverting fund to be known as the: **COMMUNITY CORRECTION-PARTNERS** Fund.
