

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Floyd is committed to the principle that each citizen of the community should have a home in a neighborhood that is safe, healthful and free from blight and deteriorating influences; and

WHEREAS, it is recognized by the Board of Commissioners that persons of low and moderate incomes are often unable to afford action to prevent deterioration of their homes and neighborhood facilities; and

WHEREAS, the increase of blight and blighting influences diminishes the quality of both dwellings and neighborhood facilities of low and moderate income families; and

WHEREAS, the unchecked advance of deteriorating influences throughout areas of Floyd County decreases the overall housing available to low and moderate income families; and

WHEREAS, the Congress of the United States had made available, through the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 as amended and extended, funds to help communities arrest the decline of facilities and preserve housing; and

WHEREAS, under the above act of Congress the Community of Development Block Grant has been made available through the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD); and

WHEREAS, the County of Floyd did submit to HUD an application for a three-year, comprehensive CDBG program for the Jefferson Gardens area of Floyd County; and

WHEREAS, the County of Floyd did receive approval from HUD for the Jefferson Gardens Community Development Program on 30 October 1978; and

WHEREAS, certain conditions now make it necessary to request certain revisions and amendments to the Jefferson Gardens Community Development Program;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Commissioners of the County of Floyd designates Vincent H. Freiburger, President of the Board of Commissioners, as the Chief Executive Officer responsible for the Housing and Community Development Block Grant program as it applies to Floyd County;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Vincent H. Freiburger is authorized to prepare and submit to HUD amendments to the Jefferson Gardens Community Development Program, with all understandings and assurances required therein; and to act as the official representative of the County of Floyd in connection with the provision of any information required by HUD in connection with the amendments.
