BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF FLOYD

WHEREAS, an enquiry has been received by the Board of Commissioners of the County of Floyd pertaining to the status of that certain roadway extending from U.S. Highway #150 to the United States Post Office located at Mount St. Francis, Indiana; and

WHEREAS, a review of the records of the Board of Commissioners of the County of Floyd has failed to disclose an easement or other grant to Floyd County, Indiana, of a right of way, and has further failed to disclose the dedication of said roadway to public use; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Floyd has deemed it to be in the public interest that said roadway be properly maintained so as to provide adequate access to the United States Post Office, located at Mount St. Francis, Indiana, and the Board has received correspondence from the United States Postmaster that unless such roadway is properly maintained postal service may be discontinued; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Floyd deems the maintenance of Mount St. Francis Drive as being in the public interest by reason of the fact that fire fighting services are provided by The Province of Our Lady of Consolation, Incorporated, the owner of the real estate traversed by Mount St. Francis Drive; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Floyd is desirous of accepting Mount St. Francis Drive into the Floyd County Highway System, provided that said roadway be dedicated to public use and that a specific easement be granted Floyd County, Indiana


NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT RESOLVED, that Mount St. Francis Drive, being a roadway extending from U.S. Highway #150 to the United States Post Office, Mount St. Francis, Indiana, be accepted into the Floyd County Highway System upon grant by The Province of Our Lady of Consolation, Incorporated, of a 60 foot easement for roadway purposes, the center line of which easement shall be coincident with the center line of Mount St. Francis Drive as it now exists and extends from U.S. Highway #150 to the United States Post Office, Mount St. Francis, Indiana.




