FLOYD COUNTY RESOLUTION NUMBER 82-6

AMENDMENT TO PERSONNEL POLICIES FOR FLOYD COUNTY, INDIANA

WHEREAS, on the 31st day of December 1980, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Floyd duly adopted personnel policies for the purpose of providing uniform guidance for department heads, elected officials, supervisors and employees; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Floyd is presently desirous of amending said personnel policies, in the manner as hereinafter set forth.

NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT RESOLVED, that subparagraph (c) of the Section of the Personnel Policies dated the 31st day of December 1980, and entitled SICK LEAVE, as amended by FCR 1982-4, dated 6 December 1982, be, and said paragraph hereby is amended by the substitution therefor of the following language:

(c) To be eligible for sick leave, an employee must report his absence to his supervisor at the commencement of business of the first day for which leave is sought. To be eligible for payment for sick leave, an employee must submit to his supervisor a physician's certificate certifying that the employee has been ill or injured and unable to perform his employment during the period of his absence, provided, that the requirement have a physicians statement shall not apply to three daily absences during each calendar year.
