FLOYD COUNTY RESOLUTION 83-5

WHEREAS, the General Assembly of the State of Indiana has abolished Daylight Saving Time; and,

WHEREAS, Floyd County is dependent upon the Louisville Metropolitan Area for business purposes; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Louisville in the State of Kentucky still recognizes Daylight Saving Time;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that one clock located on the first floor of the City County Building, Hauss Square, New Albany, Indiana, shall be maintained at the official time as prescribed by state law, being Eastern Standard Time, and that the court house hours, effective 2:00 A.M. on the last Sunday in April until 2:00 A.M. on the last Sunday in October, shall be from 7:00 A.M. Eastern Standard to 3:00 P.M. Eastern Standard Time on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday.
