

A RESOLUTION COMMITTING  
CERTAIN FUTURE REVENUES FROM THE CLARK-FLOYD LANDFILL  
TOWARD THE OPERATION EXPENSES OF THE  
FLOYD COUNTY SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT DISTRICT

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Clark County and the Board of Commissioners of Floyd County jointly own the land upon which the Clark-Floyd Landfill is located near Bennettsville, Indiana;

WHEREAS, both Clark and Floyd counties, respectively, have contracted with an operator to manage said landfill facility;

WHEREAS, both Clark and Floyd counties, respectively, have established solid waste management districts pursuant to IC 13-9.5-2.5 and said districts will likely incur operational expenses and other expenses in connection with their solid waste management district Plans, required under IC 13-9.5-4-1.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

(1) That each and every recital stated above is adopted into this Resolution;

(2) That the Board of Commissioners of Floyd County hereby commits, to the extent available and subject to the agreement of the Board of Commissioners of Clark County after discussions and negotiations, to utilize future revenues generated by the Clark-Floyd Landfill to fund the Floyd County Solid Waste Management District Plan and its implementation;

(3) To the extent such funding efforts do not meet all of the expenses of the District's Plat implementation in the future, the Board of Commissioners of Floyd County hereby commits to use good faith and best efforts to assist the cities and towns in the District to implement the Plan in their respective locales.
