## RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING APPLICATION SUBMISSION AND LOCAL MATCH COMMITMENT

RESOLUTION TO THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF FLOYD, INDIANA,
AUTHORIZING THE SUBMITTAL OF THE CFF APPLICATION
TO THE INDIANA DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE
AND ADDRESSING RELATED MATTERS

WHEREAS, the County of Floyd, Indiana recognizes the need to stimulate growth and to maintain a sound economy within its corporate limits; and

WHEREAS, the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended, authorizes the Indiana Department of Commerce to provide grants to local units of government to meet the housing and community development needs of low and moderate income persons; and

WHEREAS, the County of Floyd, Indiana, has conducted or will conduct public hearings prior to the submission of an application to the Indiana Department of Commerce, said public hearings to assess the housing, public facilities, and economic needs of its low and moderate income residents;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County of Floyd, Indiana, that:

- 1) The Center for Women and Families is authorized to prepare and submit an application for grant funding to address the needs of domestic violence victims, and to execute and administer a resultant grant including requisite general administration and project management, contracts and agreements pursuant to regulations of the Indiana Department of Commerce and the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development.
- 2) The County of Floyd, Indiana, hereby commits the requisite local funds in the amount of \$70,000, in the form of cash and pledges, as raised by the Southern Indiana Domestic Violence Task Force, as matching funds for said programs, such commitment to be contingent upon receipt of CFF funding from the Indiana Department of Commerce.
